Proposal of a panel on “Analyses and strategies to realize the human right to water”

- Nature rights and human right to water: overcoming anthropocentrism;
- Analysis of current status of water policy: corporations, UN, States’ strategies;
- What is the human right to water: vital minimum and water quality, priority of human use (personal use and sustainable production of food), universal access (mechanisms of solidarity), responsible use of water resources;
- How the human right to water can be implemented: comparing proposals (juridical instruments, public and community management).
